Preparations Complete, Construction Gears Up

TransAlta and ECN and as many as 30 community members have been hard at work since late June getting ready for major construction. Thousands of rig mats have been washed and are in place and ready to protect our land from the construction above.



SAFETY FIRST!


- We must all take responsibility for safety.

- The work will be done safely but we need you to do your part too.

With Phase 1 complete, the community will see work on the second and third phases as follows:

- Phase 2 (mid August to late September) is the construction phase and it will involve foundation installation, tower setting and wire stringing.
- Phase 3 (late September to early November) is the cleanup phase. Rig mats will be removed and the land will be remediated to the satisfaction of ECN staff.

You will see lots of activity in and around the reserve including the use of large equipment which must stay on the rig mats that have been put down. Operators are expected to conduct themselves safely and with respect for our community. Please do your part and do not approach the work or workers.
