JOB PURPOSE: A school based Occupational Therapist addresses the physical, cognitive, and sensory components for students at Kitaskinaw Education Authority. They use meaningful activities to help children and youth participate in what they need and/or want to do in order to promote physical and mental wellbeing in school. Occupational Therapists also ensure in schools that there is a focus on academics, play and leisure, social participation, self-care skills, and daily living skills. The Occupational therapists expertise includes activity and environmental analysis to and modification with a goal of reducing the barriers in school for the student.

The KEA Occupational Therapist will provide services for struggling learners and for individual students in inclusive education. Assessment throughout the school year for all students and training resources for school personnel and families as required. Participating on a collaborative, holistic Student Services Team and utilizing the Nehiyaw approach within the standards of practice as outlined by your governing body. Other duties as required by your Supervisor.
