This training will prepare participants to support event operations and help maintain a safe and welcoming environment throughout the Powwow.

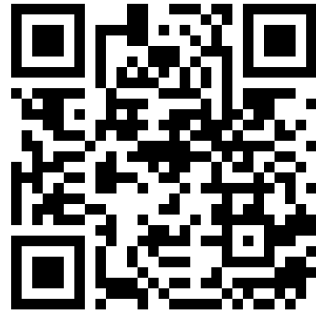

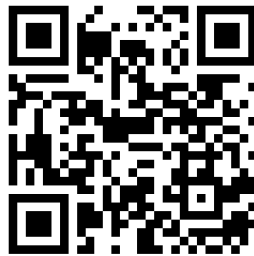
The Enoch Cree Nation Powwow Committee invites local artisans and vendors to apply for a space to showcase their work at our Annual Spring Powwow.
