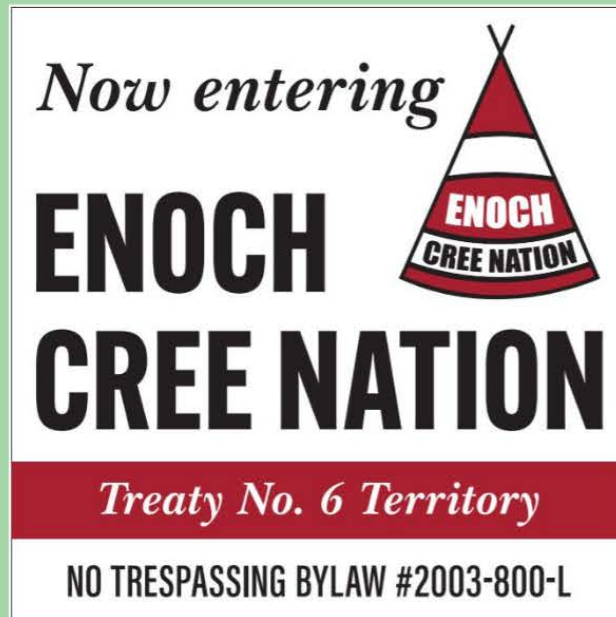

Amended & Restated Trespassing Bylaw #2003-800-L was amended to:

- ✔ **Protect the public and enhance community safety**
- ✔ **To update the Law and ensure it is enforceable within current legislation**
- ✔ **Allow for enforcement to deal with trespassing issues, undesirable activities, and the rising drug & substance abuse issues on the Nation**



Community Standards Bylaw #2025-100-CSB was developed to deal with the following issues:

- ✔ **Unsightly and Unsafe Properties**
- ✔ **Derelict & Abandoned Vehicles**
- ✔ **Excessive Noise that Disturbs the Peace of an Individual**
- ✔ **Littering, Panhandling, Public Behaviors such as Fighting, Harassment, Bullying and Encampments**
- ✔ **Use/Possession of Weapons, Hunting**
- ✔ **To Protect Ceremonial Artifacts, Cemeteries**
- ✔ **Parking such as Disabled/Handicapped Zones, Fire Lanes/Emergency Access, Elder's Parking**
- ✔ **Off-Highway Vehicle Safety and Operation**
